## Planning for 2020

It is that time of year that we start making plans for the 2020 school year. This year we have taken over 50 Kindergarten enrolments. This will impact on our total enrolment and the formation of classes for next year. With this newsletter is a survey asking your intentions for your child / children's schooling for next year. Please fill this in and return it as soon as possible as this allows us to determine our student numbers when the Department of Education is allocating staffing to our school.

## **Swim School – extra positions**

We have booked into the learn—to—swim classes for Term 4 again this year for children in years 2 to 6. The lessons begin 21<sup>st</sup> October. Please leave your name at the office with a deposit of \$5 if you are interested in this very valuable activity. We have managed to get some extra places but these will go quickly. Children who cannot confidently swim 25 metres in deep water are eligible to attend the lessons. The lessons are free and qualified teachers run the lessons. The cost is made up of pool entry and maybe transport.

## **NAPLAN** Results

Our 2019 Year 3 and 5 NAPLAN results have arrived. Each child has been issued with their results today in an addressed envelope.

While these results assist us with our planning and allocation of support we realise the individual student results are a snapshot of single assessment tasks.

If you have any concerns with your child's results please do not hesitate to contact us as the teachers have a comprehensive knowledge of your child's achievements.

## **Attendance at School**

We regularly have the Department of Education's Home School Liaison Officer visit our school to discuss student attendance. **All students must attend school every day and on time** which is 9 am for our school. If your child did not attend school you must let the school know why your child was absent. If they were sick you can send in a note, a Doctor's certificate or inform the class teacher or office staff as to why they were absent.

If they were absent for other reasons you still need to explain why your child did not attend School. We will then determine if this qualifies as a justified reason for their absence.

If your child/ren arrive late they must report to the office to receive a late note and these are recorded as partial attendance. As this is generally the English session / prime learning time 10 minutes per day / 50 minutes per week, 500 minutes per term........ They can also miss important information occurring during the day.

If you are planning a holiday during school time you need to fill out an 'Application for Extended Leave – Travel'. These are available from the office. Once filled in these need to be returned and if it follows the guidelines you will be issued with a 'Certificate of Extended Leave – Travel.' Please ensure you take this document with you when travelling. These will impact on your child's attendance record.

#### **Kindergarten Enrolments**

Enrolments for Kindergarten for 2020 are now being taken. The child needs to turn 5 by the 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2020 to be eligible to enrol.

Parents or caregivers need to fill out an enrolment form, available from the school's office, and provide the original copy of their child's birth certificate and immunisation report. Also required is proof of address which can be clarified by ringing the school office.

Orientation Day is being organised for Thursday, 7<sup>th</sup> November. Details for this day will be sent to families closer to the event.

If you have a neighbour or friend in the area whose child is eligible for enrolment please let them know of these arrangements or get them to ring the school.
