#### We are a Nut Aware School - Anaphylaxis - Reminder

We have a number of children who have been diagnosed with Anaphylaxis. This means they have a severe allergic reaction to all types of nuts. If these children are exposed to any of these products their condition can be life threatening.

Please help us to keep all our students safe by ensuring your child does not bring food containing any nuts to school. Your support helps to minimise the risk to them.



#### STUDENT SAFETY

Once again I am asking parents **not to park in the Staff Carpark** in the morning and afternoon. We have our special transport vehicles arriving and departing in the carpark as well as many of our children using the crossing and walking around this area.

Just a reminder the area in front of the school is a 'Kiss and Drop' zone. This means exactly that – give your children a kiss and say goodbye. Legally the driver cannot leave the vehicle. Again this is for the safety of our children as this area is very congested with people and children. This is also regularly patrolled by the Police.

#### Attendance at School

We regularly have the Department of Education's Home School Liaison Officer visit our school to discuss student attendance. **All students must attend school every day and** <u>on time</u> which is 9 am for our school. If your child did not attend school you must let the school know why your child was absent. If they were sick you can send in a note, a Doctor's certificate or inform the class teacher or office staff as to why they were absent.

If they were absent for other reasons you still need to explain why your child did not attend School. We will then determine if this qualifies as a justified reason for their absence.

If you are planning a holiday during school time you need to fill out an 'Application for Extended Leave – Travel'. These are available from the office. Once filled in these need to be returned and if it follows the guidelines you will be issued with a 'Certificate of Extended Leave – Travel.' Please ensure you take this document with you when travelling. These will impact on your child's attendance record.

#### Planning for 2021

It is that time of year that we start making plans for the 2021 school year. This year we are expecting around 50 Kindergarten enrolments. We would like to start our planning of classes and staffing for the 2021 year. Thank you to those who have returned the survey.

If you are planning a holiday that will coincide with the return to school dates can you contact the office for the required paperwork to ensure they are included in our enrolment numbers.

#### Kindergarten Enrolments

Enrolments for Kindergarten for 2021 are now being taken. The child needs to turn 5 by the 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2021 to be eligible to enrol.

Parents or caregivers need to fill out an enrolment form, available from the school's office, and provide the original copy of their child's birth certificate and immunisation report. Also required is proof of address which can be clarified by ringing the school office.

If you have a neighbour or friend in the area whose child is eligible for enrolment please let them know of these arrangements or get them to ring the school.
