Drop off and Pick Up of Students - IMPORTANT

It is essential that we work together as a community to ensure that the drop off and pick up of students is a safe and respectful experience. Please remember to;

- **Park safely and legally**, even if it means walking further to the school gate. Parking signs are planned with children's safety in mind.
- **Slow down to 40km/h** in the school zone and stay aware of crossings.
- **Always park and turn legally** around the school.
- **Never double park** as it puts children at risk.
- Manoeuvres such as **U-turns and three-point turns are dangerous**.
- **Never park in a bus zone** or in the school bus bay.
- Make sure your children **use the Safety Door** (rear footpath side door) to get in and out of the car.
- **Model safe and considerate behaviour** for your child – they will learn from you.

Student safety is everyone's responsibility. Please support us in keeping all of our children safe when coming to school.

Being at school and on time

Arriving at school and class on time ensures that students do not miss out on important learning activities scheduled early in the day. If your child arrives at school after 9:00am, they are required to obtain a late slip from the office. Lateness is recorded as a partial absence and must be explained by parents.

Following an absence from school you must ensure that within 7 days you provide your child's school with a verbal or written explanation for the absence. However, if the school has not received an explanation from you within 2 days, the school may contact you to discuss the absence.

- Add your child's first name and last initial (so the school knows who the book is for)
- Enter the item number from the Book Club catalogues
- You can order for multiple children at once if they attend the same school
