As we complete the term, Google Classrooms will be muted for the holidays and will reopen when we return on Tuesday 5th October. Please take the time to rest from school and enjoy time with your family.

Term 4

In Term 4, we will continue to operate under Level 4 guidelines until our stage-based return to school.

When we return on Tuesday 5th October, Learning from Home will continue with '**our school being open with minimal supervision to support those students who cannot be educated from home.** <https://education.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/advice-for-families/level-4-schools>

Learning from Home packs will continue to be sent out as they have been this term.

Students return to face-to-face learning in staggered cohorts while under stay-at-home rules. Students in Kindergarten, Year 1 are prioritised. COVID-safe operations are maintained through high rates of staff vaccination, safe rostering, physical distancing, and minimised

contact between students and staff. Students will return to face-to-face learning with NSW Health-approved COVID-safe settings on school sites in the following order:

25th October – **Kindergarten and Year 1**

1st November – **Years 2 and 6**

8th November – **Years 3, 4 and 5**

Please remember that this is the plan, however this may change if the NSW health conditions change in our area. I will continue to provide updates via School E-News.
